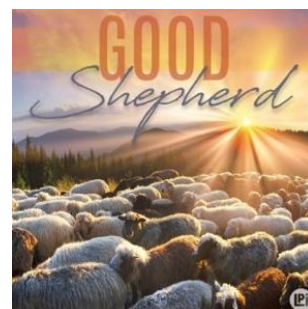
Rachel's Vineyard Retreat

Diocesan Assessment Appeal
