Last Town Wide Meeting: After having had several meetings with Fr. Joseph Busch, Episcopal Vicar and Tom Cronin, Director of Evangelization & Strategic Planning for the Diocese, the community of St. James realizes there is a possibility their church may close. The next Town Wide Meeting will be scheduled when there is something new to report.

Diocesan Assessment Appeal

This year's theme for the Diocesan Appeal is "Restore to me the joy of your Salvation and uphold me with a willing spirit". *Psalm 51:14*.

Blessed Sacrament has collected \$17,768 with 50 gifts, which is 58% of our Appeal. We need \$13,675 to reach our goal.

St. James has collected \$2,963 with 12 gifts, which is 60% of our Appeal. We need \$2,037 to reach our goal.

We are stewards of the Roman Catholic faith, working together to serve our Master up here in God's Country, the beautiful Adirondacks. We look for 100% participation not equal sacrifice. **The amount not collected will be taken out of our operating funds,** putting a strain on our budget.

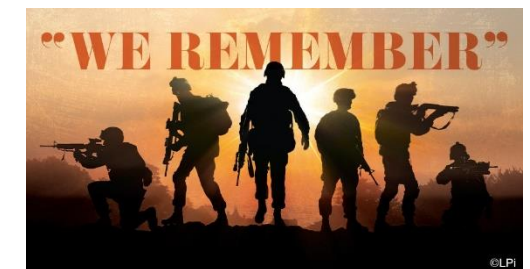
We are asked to pray from now through the end of June, when the Supreme Court will make a decision.
