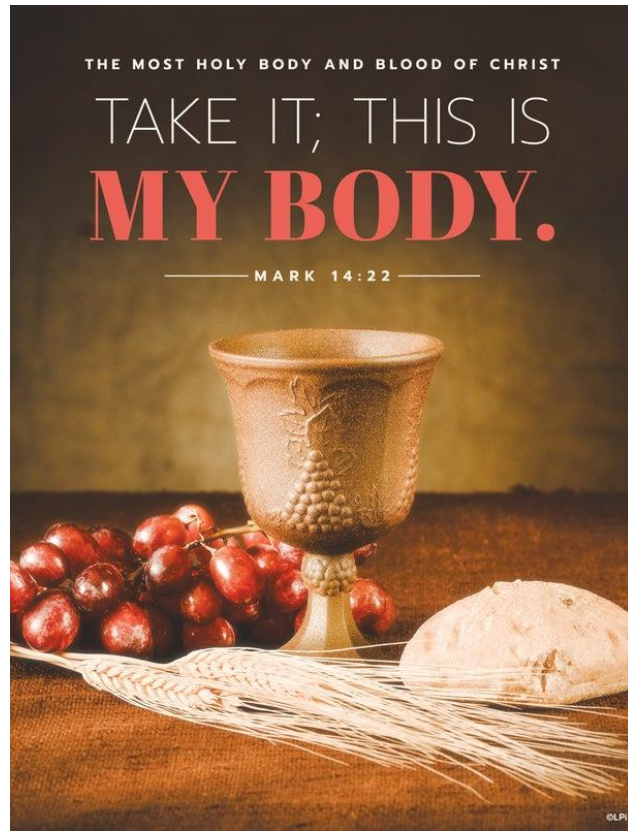

Diocesan Assessment Appeal

This year's theme for the Diocesan Appeal is "Restore to me the joy of your Salvation and uphold me with a willing spirit". *Psalm 51:14.*

Blessed Sacrament has collected \$20,193 with 57 gifts, which is 65% of our Appeal. We need \$10,850 to reach our goal. Anything our snowbirds and visitors can do to help us meet this appeal would be more than appreciated.

St. James has collected \$2,963 with 12 gifts, which is 60% of our Appeal. We need \$2,037 to reach our goal.

We are stewards of the Roman Catholic faith, working together to serve our Master up here in God's Country, the beautiful Adirondacks. We look for 100% participation not equal sacrifice.

The amount not collected will be taken out of our operating funds, putting a strain on our budget.
