

These tasks are met by answering phone calls, emails, and in-person inquiries about community programs and resources throughout the community. In addition, the caseworkers provide a safe, nonjudgmental environment for individuals and families in need and distribute Emergency Assistance Funds in qualifying cases. Please note, donations are only accepted in Warrensburg only on Mondays & Tuesdays from 9-12 pm.
