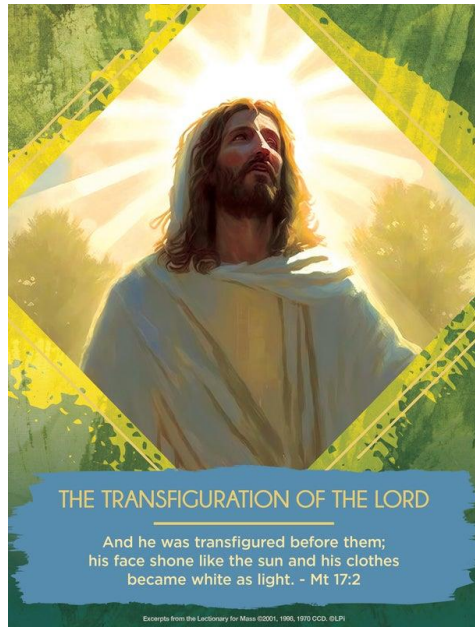

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

There are times in our lives that we get the chance to see a glimpse of heaven. It may be through the love of another, loved one or stranger.
